Hand in Hand for Healthier Babies

Your new baby needs routine well care and immunizations to maximize health and prevent illness. Unfortunately, not all insurance plans cover all well care and immunization costs. We recommend that families carefully check covered benefits with their insurance company prior to well care visits, so that they are not surprised by unexpected costs and can better budget funds to pay for their family's health care needs. We suggest asking the following questions about your insurance policy regarding well care coverage:

- Does your plan cover regular well baby care visits? Some plans do not cover any well care visits or cover them only for specific ages. You may want to check to see if your insurance plan covers all of the first year well care visits recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (shown below).
- Are there restrictions to your vaccine coverage? Some plans only cover certain vaccines, or for certain ages, or may have a maximum annual limit for vaccine coverage.

All insurance companies require that you add your newborn to your health insurance coverage within 30 days of birth. Failure to do this may result in no coverage for newborn or pediatric care and you will be responsible for all charges. Please contact your insurance company or your human resources department as soon as possible to add your newborn to your insurance policy. Once you have added the baby to your policy, please contact our business office so that we may update our records.

Please review the average well care and immunization costs for an infant's first year of life shown below. These costs are an estimate of the average well care and immunization costs and are subject to change based on changes in immunization costs etc. In addition, costs may be higher for new patients or complicated visits which may require more time.

Please note that we require payment at time of service from those who do not have health insurance, or whose insurance does not cover well care visits and/or immunizations. (There are options available in the community for low cost immunizations if your insurance plan does not cover immunizations.) 2 Week Well Care Visit & Newborn Screen	\$130
2 Month Well Care Visit & Immunizations & ASQ*	\$630
4 Month Well Care Visit, Immunizations & ASQ*	\$590
6 Month Well Care Visit, Immunizations & ASQ*	\$630
9 Month Well Care Visit & ASQ*	\$195
1 Year Well Care Visit, Immunizations & ASQ*	<u>\$660</u>
Total First Year Well Care	\$2,945
